

Another victim of *yellow lens filter peril* was this fine example, "Red16". It is known from a series of images, all alas shot very well using a camera equipped with this kind of filter. The author has drawn this example for years with an AEh-9 finish, but a recent image has turned up taken with amateur grade monochrome film which shows the rudder of this aircraft close up. It was unmistakably painted in AII Aluminium! The scheme itself consists of a very finely applied dapple (AII Green) over the fuselage and lower wings, and including the upper surface's central gull section. Plain red stars can be seen in six positions, and the tactical number was carefully painted around.
